

# Proposed Amendment to the Constitution of the United States

## The United States of America Referendum Voting Amendment

1. **The People of the United States**, consisting of all eligible citizens, shall have the **direct power to propose, vote on, and enact** federal laws referred by Congress, the President, or proposed through citizen petition in accordance with this Constitution.
2. The People shall have the **direct power to propose and vote on amendments to the Constitution**, provided that no such amendment shall be ratified without the approval of **at least two-thirds (2/3) of the votes cast** in a national referendum, in addition to meeting all other constitutional requirements for ratification.
3. **Congress shall have the power to enforce** this Article **by appropriate legislation**, but **shall not amend, weaken, or obstruct** the People's referendum powers established herein, except through the constitutional amendment process.
